- [Walter and Eliza Hall Trust Opportunity scholarship](#) - open to current Year 12 students with a permanent physical disability intending on completing their senior secondary education in 2021 and progressing to University in 2022 to study a degree.

Tertiary transition applications have been open since May and **close midnight 3rd August**. Applications for **Secondary** scholarships close **midnight 14th September**, and for the **Primary** school scholarships, **22nd September**.
